Because *capitalism* makes food a source of profit, not a source of nutrition! **Because Food Grows on Trees**. Because we need community not control. Because we need homes not jails.

Hunger is caused by **poverty**, not **scarcity**. The first thing to know is that hunger is not an accident, in the US or anywhere else. There is no shortage of food here in America. The other thing to remember about hunger is that the well-off in any country never go hungry, even in famine. Formerly broad-based, America's economy has not "turned around," it has been turned over. The richest 1% owns more than the poorest 92% combined. The economy now caters to a globalized elite whose lives are sealed off from public accountability.

El hambre está causada por **pobreza**, no por **escasez**. No hay una escasez de la comida en los EEUU. Los ricos en cualquier país nunca se quedan hambrientos, aun en carestía. La economía del EEUU que anteriormente estaba distribuida entre más personas ha estado echado de un capirotazo. El 1% de los más ricos poseen más que el 92% de la población, que son los más pobres. La economía ahora abastece a un élite cuyas vidas están guardadas de escrutinio y responsabilidad.

An estimated 26% of edible food is thrown away every year in this country. Meanwhile, people go hungry, eat inadequate meals, and starve. Sacramento largely ignores the growing numbers of homeless people sleeping in its streets.

Un estimado 26% de la comida es tirada a la basura cada año en los estados unidos. Mientras tanto, la gente padece de hambre o no come comida nutritiva, y se muere de hambre.

Filosfía Básica

Se recicla comida: Cada día, suficiente comida se desecha para dar de comer a todos los necesitados que no tienen de comer. Comida No Bombas recobra comida nutritiva vegetariana que de otra manera hubiera sido desechara, para prepararla y servirla a la gente. Colectamos comida de supermercados, tianguis y empresas locales que tal vez no se puede vender porque se pasó de la fecha de caducidad.

Decisión por el consenso: No usamos el método del “ganador toma todo”. Comida No Bombas cree que todos los miembros del grupo deben tener una oportunidad completa de participar en formar las decisiones del grupo. El método del concenso asegura que los deseos de la mayoría no despida los deseos de los demás. El proceso de consenso nos obliga que resolvamos conflictos por negociación y compromiso en vez de denegar o ignorar la minoría.

No violencia: Nuestra sociedad está dominada por violencia. Presiones constantes del crimen, la violencia de policía y la posibilidad de guerra afecta nuestra vida diaria. La autoridad del gobierno está basada en amenazas y el uso de violencia en tierra propia y en los países extranjeros.

Comida No Bombas está comprometido a la visión de una sociedad que es motivada por compartir y amor. La pobreza es violencia. Mientras nuestra sociedad sigue acumulando riquezas para los pocos, relega a millones de personas a la pobreza y a la hambrientad. Esto, combinado con represión de parte de la policía, cuidado medico inadequado, y muchas formas de discriminación priva cada de nosotros de una vida plena y llena de amor. La industria comercial de comida es tambien basada en violencia. En su proceso, mata millones de animales, y contamina el planeta usando pesticidas y fertilizantes de químicos. La industria deja que toneladas de comida sea echada en la basura. Comida No Bombas usa comida vegetariana y trata de usar comida cultivada organicamente. En compartir comida gratis y por acciones no violentas, Comida No Bombas reta la violencia de la sociedad y así resalta la injusticia del militarismo y la pobreza.



Basic Principles:

Food Recycling: Enough food is wasted each day to feed everyone who is hungry. Food Not Bombs recovers healthy nutritious vegetarian food that would have been otherwise discarded, to prepare and serve to people. We collect food that may not be saleable (because it has passed its shelf date or is blemished) from grocery stores, farmers' markets and local businesses.

Consensus Decision Making: Rather than relying on a system of winner take all, Food Not Bombs believes that every member of the group should have a full opportunity to participate in shaping all the group's decisions. The consensus process insures that the will of the majority doesn't dismiss the values and contributions of everyone else. Consensus process forces us to resolve conflicts through negotiation and compromise rather than overruling and dismissing the minority.

Non Violence: Our society is dominated by violence. Constant threats of crime, police violence, and the ongoing possibility of nuclear war affect our daily lives. The authority and power of our government is based on the threat and use of violence at home and abroad. Food Not Bombs is committed to a vision of a society that is motivated by love and sharing. While our society pursues the massive accumulation of wealth for the few, it relegates millions to hunger and homelessness. This combined with police oppression, inadequate healthcare and various forms of discrimination deprive each of us of a vibrant and loving way of life. The commercial food industry is also predicated on violence. It involves the slaughtering of millions of animals and the poisoning of the planet by the use of chemical pesticides and fertilizers. It also allows tons of food to go to waste to insure profits. Food Not Bombs uses vegetarian food and makes efforts to use organically grown produce. Food Not Bombs challenges the violence of society by the free sharing of food and non-violent actions that highlight the injustices of militarism and poverty.

Charity Never

The following is a summarized essay by Peter Moore.

Food Not Bombs is not and never will be a charity. Charity ignores and distracts from the causes of poverty and hunger. By throwing spare change into a hat or tithing to a church, the rich and middle class absolve themselves of responsibility for the poor. Yet, the economic institution they thrive on, capitalism, is the same mechanism which creates and institutionalizes poverty.

Instead of reinforcing the myth of charity, Food Not Bombs enacts the principles of Mutual Aid and Solidarity to raise awareness about the causes of poverty and to rally against government and business attacks on human dignity.

Hunger is perhaps the most terrible effect of poverty. When we apply the principles of Solidarity and Mutual Aid, we understand that we all have the same basic need - a roof, clothing, work and food. It's the recognition that as soon as one person is denied these necessities, inequality is created and social injustice is perpetuated. From this awareness comes the rational and passionate desire to free all people and work together for equality and economic justice! Mutual Aid is the concrete enactment of solidarity. With every serving, we demystify for ourselves and the public that poor people are bad people.

By distributing food that wasn't pretty enough to sell, Food Not Bombs rips off the pretty face of consumerism to reveal the waste it creates. With every serving, FNB calls for economic justice and the satisfaction of human needs as an international priority for all people.
